2) Histoires de l'UNESCO (1945-2015)

Au cours de ces dernières années l'histoire internationale a connu un intérêt général et scientifique accru. C'est en réponse à ce développement historiographique qu'une nouvelle revue numérique, INTERNATIONAL HISTORIES / HISTOIRES INTERNATIONALES, a été lancée et proposera un espace pour une nouvelle histoire internationale que s'intéressera au passé, présent et avenir de la société civile globale, la sphère publique internationale, les institutions internationales, le globalisme et l'internationalisme. Ses éditeurs seront Glenda Sluga, Poul Duedahl, Ibrahima Thioub, Jean-François Sirinelli, Akira Iriye et Jens Boel.
